Religious Education For 2022-2023

Dear Parents & Guardians,

It is with great joy that this email is sent. This is to announce the first day of classes for the St. Helen Religious Education Program:

6th & 7th Grades: Monday, October 3, 2022. Students are strongly encouraged to arrive between 6:45pm & 6:55pm. Classes start promptly at 7pm. Students will gather in Fr. Dooley Hall and line-up by their assigned catechist; this is for the 1st day of class ONLY. After the 1st day, students will arrive at the main school entrance. Dismissal is at 8:15pm from the school entrance on ALL school days, including the 1st day of class.

Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd & 3rd Grades: Wednesday, September 28, 2022. Students are strongly encouraged to arrive between 3:30pm & 3:40pm. Classes start promptly at 3:45pm. Students & parents will meet their catechists in Fr. Dooley Hall. This is ONLY for the 1st day of classes. After the 1st day of classes, students will be dropped off at the Fr. Dooley Hall entrance where they will be greeted and escorted to their classrooms. Dismissal will be from the Fr. Dooley Hall entrance on ALL school days for all grades, including the 1st day of class. Dismissal time for Kindergarten & 1st grade students is at 4:50pm. 2nd & 3rd grade students are dismissed at 5pm.

4th & 5th Grades: Thursday, September 29, 2022. Students are strongly encouraged to arrive between 3:30pm & 3:40pm. Classes start promptly at 3:45pm. Students and parents will meet their catechists in Fr. Dooley Hall. This is ONLY for the 1st day of classes. After the 1st day of classes, students will be dropped off at the Fr. Dooley Hall entrance where they will be greeted by a member of the St. Helen Religious Education staff, and they will then proceed to their classrooms. Dismissal will be from the Fr. Dooley Hall entrance on ALL school days for all grades, including the 1st day of class.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Classes will be in person unless otherwise mandated by authorized organizations. In the event of on-line classes, notice will be provided via email and text messaging (for those who provided the authorization and necessary information). Additional emails will be sent soon with the school year calendar, rules and regulations and all other pertinent information.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Receipt of this notification is not a guarantee that your child is registered for school year 2022-23. If you have not submitted the re-registration form and payment, your child is not registered. Please submit ASAP. If you need a re-registration form kindly request one in writing, it will be emailed to you.

Religious instruction for special education & RCIC classes will be begin at a later date. More information will follow.

Once your Mass intention has been processed you will be contacted by phone, email or regular mail.

1. The **Monday through Saturday 9:00AM Masses** are **one intention only**. Offering for each 9:00AM Mass is **\$15.00**.
2. The **Saturday 5:00PM Mass** will remain for **recently deceased only**, and will have a total of **ten (10) intentions**. **Recently deceased intentions only** will be taken for Saturday 5:00PM Masses **beginning November 1, 2022**. **Saturday 5:00PM Mass intentions may not be requested when the Book is opened**. Offering for each Saturday 5:00PM Mass intention is **\$10.00**.
3. The **Sunday 8:00AM, 9:30 & 11:00AM Masses** are **one intention only**. Offering is **\$25.00** each.
4. The **Sunday 12:30PM Mass** is a **multiple-intention Mass**, and will have a total of **seven (7) intentions**. Offering for each 12:30PM Mass intention is **\$10.00**.

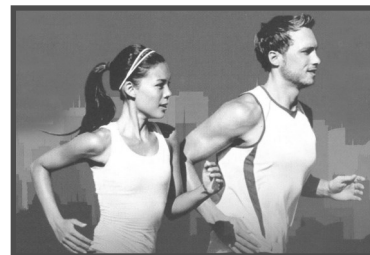
